

TOWN OF FIFIELD REGULAR BOARD MEETING  
MINUTES OF April 2, 2015

**ROLL CALL:** Meeting was brought to order on April 2, 2015 at 6:30 p.m. at the Fifield Town Hall. Roll Call: D. Noetzel, J. Hintz, J. Wierzba present. Also present were S. Putnam and 6 others.

**MINUTES:** Motion (Hintz, Wierzba) to accept the minutes of the March 19, 2015 regular board meeting. Motion approved, voice vote.

**TOWN CREW REPORT:** T. Fleming reported that Olynick, after converting their quote from tons to cubic yards, was the lowest bidder for gravel crushing and was awarded the bid. He attended an annual Diggers Hotline safety meeting. The crew attended the MSHA Refresher training course held today in Phillips except for T. Faller who had a medical issue. He has been rescheduled to attend the training in two weeks. The City of Park Falls will sweep the streets in town for \$1,200 and will have the work done in one day, as opposed to the crew taking three days to sweep. The crew is catching up on maintenance work.

**FIRE DEPARTMENT REPORT:** T. Mantor, Fire Dept. #2 reported that activity has been quiet. The rack for the pickup is in and he has ordered the ladders. W. Felch, Fire Dept. #1 reported that activity has been quiet. More engine work is being done.

**DISCUSS CONTRACTING FOR BEAVER CONTROL SERVICES:** Motion (Wierzba, Hintz) to contract with APHIS, USDA for beaver control services for this year. Motion approved, voice vote.

**DISCUSS FINDINGS FROM PRICE COUNTY VETERANS SERVICE REGARDING ASSISTANCE FOR THE STATE HIGHWAY 13 WAYSIDE:** D. Lapp reported that T. Harvey, Price County Veterans Service is looking into helping out with maintenance and possibly helping financially with the wayside. T. Harvey will attend the town's annual meeting on April 21<sup>st</sup> and present more information.

**DISCUSS PURCHASE OF LAWNMOWER:** T. Fleming reported on a quote for a Ferris mower, 52" deck, vacuum system from Polacek Implement Inc. for \$9,800 and a Kubota from Lulich for \$12,000. Motion, (Hintz, Wierzba) to purchase the Ferris lawnmower from Polacek Implement Inc. for \$9,800. Motion approved, voice vote.

**DISCUSS HORSESHOE PITS AT MOVRICH PARK:** The Chair made the board aware that the L. Lobermeier family may be interested in constructing horseshoe pits in memory of their father. No action was taken.

**DRIVEWAY ACCESS PERMITS:** None.

**PUBLIC COMMENT:** L. Bjork, local Boy Scout was present because he is working on his Citizen and Community Badge. He asked questions of the board regarding issues discussed during the meeting.

**CORRESPONDENCE:** Correspondence included an invitation to the Park Falls Area Chamber of Commerce Spring Banquet, Diggers Hotline maps, CDBG's semi-annual MBE/WBE Report that the Chairman signed, invitation to attend the Great Lakes Timber Professionals 7<sup>th</sup> Annual Meeting, WI TIC invitation to attend their free "Road Diets" workshop, Price County's Notice of Auction to Sell Tax Delinquent Real Estate that includes the former L. Baars property in Fifield, and Chequamegon Public Schools Foundation Inc.'s request for funding to finance new restrooms at the Park Falls Area Athletic Complex.
