

TOWN OF FIFIELD REGULAR BOARD MEETING
MINUTES OF February 4, 2016

ROLL CALL: Meeting was brought to order on February 4, 2016 at 6:30 p.m. at the Fifield Town Hall. Roll Call: D. Noetzel, J. Hintz, J. Wierzba present. Also present were S. Putnam and 4 others.

MINUTES: Motion (Hintz, Wierzba) to approve the minutes of the January 21, 2016 special and regular board meetings. Motion approved, voice vote.

TOWN CREW REPORT: T. Fleming reported that the Town of Worcester asked if the Town of Fifield could do some shouldering work for them and in return they would haul gravel for the Town of Fifield. The board saw no problem with allowing this. The crew has been busy plowing snow.

FIRE DEPARTMENT REPORT: W. Felch, Fire Dept. #1 reported on 2 snowmobile accidents that resulted in one driver suffering bruised vertebrae and the other a broken leg, as well as two fire calls, one for a chimney fire in the Town of Flambeau and the other a clothes dryer fire at the Ridgeview Apartments. He also reported that he will be picking up the 1995 International Tender from Deerfield tomorrow and that he has one person taking the Firefighter One class. He asked the board to consider selling their old tender. In March, the State will be conducting an audit relating to the 2% dues his department receives. T. Mantor, Fire Dept. #2 reported on one snowmobile accident otherwise activity was quiet. He has three people going to the Firefighter One class. His department is being audited also by the State in regard to the 2% dues they receive.

CORRESPONDENCE: Correspondence included conversations with Joe Benbenek, WisDOT regarding the status of the Squaw Creek Replacement project and Phil Richards, WI DNR on the closure of the underground storage tank file for W7179 Balsam which Richards says he hasn't worked on yet.
