Minutes of April 16, 2019
Town of Fifield Annual Meeting

Present: K. Balzar, J. Jontry and 16 attendees.

Call to Order: The Annual Town Meeting was brought to order by K. Balzar on Tuesday, April 16, 2019 at 7:00 p.m. at the Fifield Town Hall.

A **MOTION** was made by F. Sevcik and seconded by R. Lapp to accept the minutes of the April 17, 2018 Annual Town Meeting. Motion approved, voice vote (16, 0).

Presentation of the 2018 Annual Report: J. Jontry presented the 2018 Annual Report. A **MOTION** was made by T. Fleming and seconded by L. Wenzel to accept the 2018 Annual Report as presented. Motion approved, voice vote (16, 0).

Discuss Issues Brought Forth by Town Electors: F. Sevcik presented the following topics for consideration: Alternative meetings at Fifield Town Hall and Pike Lake Fire Hall; a rule preventing the supervision of employees with family ties; detailed time reporting system for the road crew; revised highway road strategy to accommodate the surrounding environment and connecting roads; paving of Cys Drive. B. Custer requested paving of Brahmstead Road. L. Wenzel inquired about a petition that was made approximately 15 years ago to pave Simon Road. B. Felch suggested that the Board have only one meeting per month going forward.

Take Action on those Issues Authorized Under WI Statutes: No action will be taken at this time.

ACCOMPLISHMENTS

- The Town purchased a new Komatsu loader, replacing the 21-year-old John Deere loader.
- 13,000 cubic yards of gravel were crushed at the town pit. Over 2,500 cubic yards of gravel was added on Cys Drive.
- The road crew finished ditching, seeding and mulching for erosion control on Meyer Road.
- The Town began researching the process for purchasing a small parcel of land on Dam Road necessary for creating a new intersection at Hicks Landing Road to improve safety. The crew began clearing the right-of-way, including stump removal, shaping of ditches and culvert installation in anticipation of creating the new intersection.
- The Town received \$2,363 in state grant money for recycling efforts, and \$1,405 in revenues for the sale of recyclable materials including scrap metal and used oils. New video monitoring equipment was installed at both the Fifield and Pike Lake transfer sites.
- The Crew rejuvenated the pavilion, picnic tables and playground equipment -- including a new slide -- at Movrich Park.
