

TOWN OF FIFIELD REGULAR BOARD MEETING  
MINUTES OF August 2, 2018

**ROLL CALL:** Meeting was brought to order on August 2, 2018 at 6:30 p.m. at the Fifield Town Hall. Roll Call: K. Balzar, J. Hintz, J. Wierzba. Also present were B. Felch, T. Fleming, J. Jontry and 3 others.

**MINUTES:** Motion (Hintz, Balzar) to approve the Minutes of the July 26, 2018 Regular Board Meeting. Motion approved, voice vote (3, 0).

**TOWN CREW REPORT:** T. Fleming reported that Gary Kessler from the Town of Sherman asked if we could grade for a day on Springstead Road in exchange for two days of truck time. The Board approved the request at Ted's discretion. Work is continuing on the Sailor Lake project.

**FIRE DEPARTMENT REPORT:** Fire Department #1: B. Felch reported that the department responded to a motorcycle accident last Saturday. A committee has been formed to do a hiring drive to recruit two new volunteers to replace the two who moved away. Fire Department #2: T. Birchell reported to K. Balzar, no activity.

**UPDATE ON SQUAW CREEK CULVERT REPLACEMENT PROJECT:** M. Beuning was working on an updated cost; the cost of sheet piling was underestimated. He is working with the Federal Highway Administration to try to help us out on the cost, and requested the Town provide a dollar amount, verbally, that we would be willing to spend additionally to keep the contract going. The Board agreed to possibly commit verbally to an additional \$20,000.

**UPDATE ON CY'S DRIVE:** Concerning the letter to residents discussed at the last Board meeting, K. Balzar researched and provided information to the Wisconsin Towns Association attorney for review and is awaiting a response.

**DRIVEWAY ACCESS PERMITS:** None.

**PUBLIC COMMENT:** F. Sevcik, on behalf of the Lion's Club, inquired about the possibility of beer sales at the Mallak fundraiser.

**CORRESPONDENCE:** K. Balzar received an e-mail regarding the cost of a full burial at Forest Home Cemetery vs. the cost of burying cremated remains. M. Behling (FHC Administrator) has made a suggestion about prices, which will be on the agenda for the next Board meeting. J. Jontry presented an e-mail from R. Mace at Pike Lake asking about selective mowing on side roads to preserve milkweed for Monarch butterflies. T. Fleming indicated that mowing will not be done in that area until after Labor Day.

**REVIEW INVOICES:** Motion (Balzar, Hintz) to accept invoices for payment. Motion approved, voice vote (3, 0).

**ADJOURN:** Motion at 7:20 p.m. (Wierzba, Hintz) to adjourn. Motion approved, voice vote (3, 0).
