

TOWN OF FIFIELD REGULAR BOARD MEETING
Minutes of January 2, 2020

ROLL CALL: The meeting was brought to order on January 2, 2020 at 6:30 p.m. at the Fifield Town Hall. Present: W. Felch, J. Hintz, B. Salm. Also present T. Fleming, J. Jontry and five others.

MINUTES OF DECEMBER 19, 2019 REGULAR BOARD MEETING: A MOTION (J. Hintz, B. Salm) was made to approve the Minutes of the December 19, 2019 Regular Board Meeting. Motion approved, voice vote (3, 0).

TOWN CREW REPORT: T. Fleming reported the crew has not been able to use the 2001 Freightliner to plow snow. The air tanks and valves are bad and new parts will be arriving shortly. A new set of parts is needed to rebuild the tire chains on the loader which will cost between \$2K-3K. Gehrman Logging is about halfway finished at Twin Lakes. Ice dams on the roof of the Town Hall tore gutters off over the shop and these will need to be replaced in spring.

FIRE DEPARTMENT REPORTS: Fire Department #1: B. Lobermeier reported one fire call and four EMR calls in December. The extrication class on December 14 was a success with 6 departments and 18 firefighters attending. 2019 year-end totals: 43 EMR calls and 17 fire calls (some accidents, some mutual aid). Fire Department #2: No report.

DISCUSS OBTAINING BIDS FOR TRASH COLLECTION: A MOTION (Hintz, Salm) was made to advertise for bids in the next two issues of the local newspaper. Motion approved, voice vote (3, 0). Letters will also be sent to Waste Management, JB Disposal, Advance and Eagle.

APPOINTMENT OF NEW POLL WORKERS FOR 2020-2021 TERM: A MOTION (Salm, Hintz) was made to appoint poll workers for the 2020-21 term as follows: A. Liebelt, N. Shilts, B. Salm, R. Thorbjornsen, S. Putnam and R. Wenzel for Ward 1; D. Stein, S. Sironi, C. Birchell, J. Schuppel, J. Nelson, A. Sloane, M. Sloane, S. Sniatynski and P. Ahles for Ward 2. Motion carried, voice vote (3, 0).

DRIVEWAY ACCESS PERMITS: None.

PUBLIC COMMENT: None.

CORRESPONDENCE: Palecek sent us a new rate listing for grave openings. This will be revisited at the next meeting. W. Felch and the Town received a letter from the DNR regarding bridge loads. The Board members signed the warning letter which will be sent to residents violating the ordinance regarding snow being plowed into roadways.

REVIEW INVOICES: A motion (Hintz, Salm) was made to approve invoices for payment. Motion carried, voice vote (3, 0).
